Here lyeth buried SARAH MEDLICOTT wife of WILLIAM MEDLICOTT, Citizen and Grocer of London, one of the daughters and co-heirs of Mr. ROBERT GROSVENOR, late Citizen and Ironmonger of London, deceased. She dyed the 14th day of May, Anno Dom. 1664, Aetatis 51. Here lyeth also the body of the said WILLIAM MEDLICOTT husband of the above named SARAH MEDLICOTT, who departed this life the 23rd day of September, Anno D'ni 1667.</p>	752
<p>On a flat Stone going into the Chancel. M.S. LOUISAE PATTLE, Ob XIV January, 1789, Aet.2. Qui dedit rapuit; benedictum sit Domini nomen. CHARLOTTE PATTLE, nata v. August, ob. XIX Sept. 1791. R.I.P.</p>	753
<p>On the floor of the Nave, part hid by a pew. Near this place interred MRS. JANE HAYNE 1762</p>	754
<p>Here lyeth the body of HENRY MISTEP, Esqre. who departed this life the 15th day of March, 1719, aged 87 years. Also the body of JANE his wife who departed this life the 18th day of Feb., 1685.</p>	755
<p>Here resteth in hope of a joyfull resurrection to life eternal, the body of SUSANNA PARKHURST youngest daughter of JOHN MISTER Esq. and the wife of the REVEREND JOHN PARKHURST. She departed this life December the 8th, 1759, aged 37 years, leaving three children, SUSANNA, JOHN and CHARLES. Here the weary are at rest.</p>	756
<p>JOHN MISTER, Esq. born the 15th day of March, 1689, died the 1st of June 1763. This tomb was erected by his eldest and best beloved daughter, MARY, now wife of WILLIAM THORNTON, of Thornville in the County of York, sole Executrix.</p>	757
