

Prefabs - South Coast Memories

Some of my earliest memories are of living in a prefab. It was in Curtis Road, West Ewell and we moved in when I was a two years old, we lived there for five years, it was a single storey home with two bedrooms, a lounge, Kitchen and bathroom. I remember that it was always warm and cosy. There was a coal burning fire with glass doors in the lounge which provided hot water and warm air into the rooms. I shared the small bedroom with my younger sister, we had a garden to play in and there was a vegetable plot where we grew our own produce.

We move to Epsom Wells Estate after my second sister was born.
